

Justice Douglas, 67, And a Student, 23, Married on Coast

LOS ANGELES, July 15 (UPI)—Supreme Court Justice William O. Douglas, 67 years old, married a 23-year-old college senior tonight in the Encino home of a couple they had not met before the ceremony.

The bride was Cathleen Curran Heffernan of Portland, Ore.

Superior Judge Edward R. Brand performed the ceremony in the home of Mr. and Mrs. Ed Silver in a home high in the Hollywood Hills overlooking the San Fernando Valley.

Before starting the ceremony Justice Douglas and the petite bride said they had met about a year ago through mutual friends in Portland.

Earlier today the couple obtained a marriage license in Santa Monica Courthouse.

Miss Heffernan, Justice Douglas's fourth wife, is a sociology and psychology major at Mary L. Hurst College, an exclusive Roman Catholic girls' school in Portland.

The wedding followed the remarriage of Justice Douglas, 26, in a civil ceremony in Great Falls, Mont., on June 27, three days after her divorce became final.

Her new husband is Roger W. Nicholson, 27, program director of the Sky Mountain Ranch near Great Falls. Mr. Nicholson, born in Scotland, came to the United States two years ago.

Before moving to Montana, Nicholson had worked for the Job Corps in Colorado and North Carolina.
